The Grand Canyon is a very colorful, steep-sided gorge, carved by the Colorado River, in the U.S. state of Arizona. It is largely contained within the Grand Canyon National Park—one of the first national parks in the United States. Nearly two billion years of Earth's history has been exposed as the Colorado River. The all-glass, balcony-like "Skywalk" extends over the edge of the Grand Canyon, 4,000 feet (1,200 meters) above the Colorado River. The Skywalk is scheduled to open to the public in March 2007 as part of a new resort on the reservation. The resort, known as Grand Canyon West, is to include a re-created Indian village and a restaurant perched on the edge of the canyon. Tourism is the reservation's biggest source of income.
